RULES & INFORMATION

1. **The Judge's decision is final.**
2. All stallions must be in possession of a current Breed Society License.
3. The exhibitor of any pony misbehaving will be asked to remove it from the ring immediately.
4. A member shall not knowingly exhibit a pony bred, leased or produced by the judge, his/her immediate family or his/her employer.
5. Classes will be cancelled, amalgamated or divided at the discretion of the Secretary.
6. Correctly secured British Standard skull caps/riding hats must be worn at all times when mounted.
7. Handlers 16 years of age and under (on day of show) must wear a correctly secured British Standard skull cap/riding hat at all times when leading a pony on the showground.
8. All colts/stallions (other than foals and yearlings) to be shown in correctly fitted suitable bits.
9. No spurs to be worn at all, anywhere on the showground.
10. Novice Ridden & Leading Rein Class - all ponies to be shown in a suitable snaffle bridle.
11. Leading Rein Class - the leading rein to be affixed to the noseband.
12. The Organisers accept no responsibility whatsoever for any loss, damage or injury to any spectator, rider, animal or property howsoever caused.
13. Dogs to be on a lead at all times whilst on the showground.

ADDITIONAL RULES FOR NPS CLASSES

NPS Qualifying Rounds, Breed Show Rules: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Books. Part bred are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at Breed Shows ponies can qualify for the finals even if their owners are not members.

Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 2-4 August 2022. In all NPS ridden classes, stallions MUST display a stallion bridle marker available from the NPS office or from any other society.

Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second place ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white armband in classes where this is indicated. These ponies are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show.

Entry Fees on the day:- EPS Members £10.00 per class, Non-members £12.00 per class

- CLASS 14 **The NPS M&M / SHOWING CLASSICS Lead Rein** Championship Qualifier (MM-LR)
Open to mares and geldings four years or over not exceeding 122cms. To be shown in a snaffle bit. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but must not have attained their 9th birthday before the 1st January in the current year.
- CLASS 15 **The NPS/Robinson NATIVE SHOW TEAM M&M Junior Ridden**
National Championship Qualifier (MM-JR)
Open to mares and geldings four years and over not exceeding 138cms.
Riders must not have attained their 14th birthday before the first of January in the current year.
- CLASS 16 **The NPS/PICTON M&M NOVICE RIDDEN** National Championship (MM-NR)
Open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old and over.
Pony not to have before 1st January in the current year: won an open NPS affiliated mixed M&M ridden class, qualified for Olympia, HOYS or RIHS Open M&M Ridden classes, qualified for the M&M Novice or Intermediate Ridden final at the NPS Summer Champ Show. Ponies can compete as novices in this competition for two consecutive years provided they do not submit an entry to the final in the first year. If a pony qualifies for HOYS or RIHS in its second year it is immediately de-noviced and cannot compete in the Picton Final.
- CLASS 17 **The NPS/RINGSIDE STUD M&M Open Ridden** National Championship Qualifier (MM-OR)
Open to stallions, mares and geldings four years and over.

The following class is a qualifier for the Supreme In-Hand qualifier at Stoneleigh Horse Show, 4th-5th September 2021. The Supreme In-Hand Qualifier held at Stoneleigh Horse Show will offer two qualifying places for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, 6th-10th October 2021. The objective of the competition is to find the supreme light horse or pony in-hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses).

The Champion horse or pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete in the Supreme In-Hand Semi Final, provided it has not already won a Supreme In-Hand qualifier in 2021.

*Champion Senior from Classes 1-6 & Champion Youngstock from classes 9-11 if eligible.

If the Champion has already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2021 or is ineligible, then the Reserve Champion may come forward to Stoneleigh, provided it has not already qualified and is eligible. If both Champion and Reserve Champion have already qualified for Horse of the Year Show 2021 or are ineligible then the Semi-Final will not be represented at Stoneleigh. * Foal champions and geldings four years old and over are not eligible to compete or eligible to qualify for Horse of the Year Show.

In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the Semi Final qualification will not pass down to the Reserve Champion in the 2nd and any subsequent sections.

All classes are open to Yearlings, 2 year olds, 3 year olds, Stallions, broodmares and barren mares only. Broodmares must be with foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy. Mares which have not yet foaled or that have lost their foals are eligible to enter with a relevant certificate of pregnancy for the following year.

There will be no direct entry into Supreme In-Hand Championship Semi Final, all animals must be a section champion or reserve champion (as applicable).

Judges need not be registered on any society Judge's panel but must possess sufficient experience to judge. Data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit www.grandstandentries.com.
