Equine Flu Vaccinations

Foals: Foals under 7 months may be entered without vaccination but should have their passport application form lodged with the Society.

Foals over 7 months and adult ponies: Passports with vets signatures and vaccine details must be produced when collecting entry numbers.

Foals over 7 months born in 2021 will be accepted with a single vaccination. A form will be available with the entry form for proof of vaccination via the vet.

Any pony without the required vaccination details will not be allowed to stay at the Centre.

RULES

1. The judge's decision is final.
2. All ponies are to be exhibited in accordance with E.P.S show & production rules.
3. All 2 & 3 year old colts are to be shown in suitable bits.
4. All 2 & 3 year old colts to be handled by a responsible person over the age of 14 years.
5. The classes for Moor bred ponies are restricted to ponies born to mares in severely disadvantaged areas as set out by the E.P.S.
6. All ponies must be registered with the E.P.S, with the exception of foals who have not had an inspection but must be by registered parents.
7. Any objection must be lodged with the secretary within 15 minutes of the completion of the class accompanied by a written objection and a £15 deposit. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is upheld.
8. An exhibitor may not knowingly exhibit a pony bred, sold, leased, produced or trained by the judge, his/her immediate family or his/her employer.
9. The committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
10. The organizers, committee, its officers and officials accept no responsibility what so ever for any accident or loss on the show ground to any spectators, competitors, their ponies or property.
11. In all classes whips/ canes must not exceed an overall length of 75cm (30'')
12. An exhibitor may not show under a judge for whom he or she has produced a pony in the last 12 months. (The exhibitor is the owner, lessee or the person who produces and or shows the pony).
13. All foals must be weaned and be over 16 weeks old.
14. All foals must be shown in suitable head collars or halters. No foal is to shown in a bit of any type.
15. All children under the age of 16 must wear a skull cap, hard hat with safety harness according to the current British Standard (4472 or 6473) and NPS rules whilst handling ponies.
16. No entries will be accepted by email.
17. All Ponies must have a current Flu Vaccination.



Directions

Horse Box Car Park

At the war memorial in the centre of Cannington village, take the turning onto Rodway. Take the turning right, at the peak of the hill. Carry straight ahead pass the Golf Course and the Equestrian Centre is located on the left hand side at the end of the track.

Spectator Parking

Car Parking for spectators is on the right of the track on the grass verge.

PONIES CAN BE EXCERSED IN THE OUTSIDE SCHOOL, WHICH IS ALSO TO BE USED AS THE COLLECTING RING, DO NOT WAIT IN FRONT OF THE MAIN DOOR FOR YOUR CLASS.
