Class 2. 1,2 & 3 year old filly or gelding. Special rosettes as above.

Youngstock Championship (1st & 2nd from class 1 & 2)

Class 3. Related Pairs. Two ponies any age, directly related (parent/progeny, full or half siblings)

Class 4. Stallion 4 and over.

Class 5. Mare or Gelding 4 and over. Special to best gelding.

Senior Championship (1st & 2nd from class 4 & 5) Supreme Championship

Exmoor Pony Society Rules apply to this event. They are available on the EPS website. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be familiar with the rules.

Exhibitors must be EPS members.

Ponies must be registered in Section 1 of the EPS stud book.
