Entries may be taken on the day **ONLY** if the pony is already pre entered.
All ponies entering the showground MUST hold up to date flu vaccinations, annual boosters are sufficient although cannot be given within 7 days of the show. Spot checks will be made.

Overnight on-site stabling is available, please contact the secretary to book.
While the show is affiliated to EPS, NPS, NCPA & Equifest membership is NOT required to enter ANY class

Classes affiliated to the NPS will be run under NPS Breed Show rules which can be found at www.nationalponysociety.com, you do not have to be a member to compete or qualify. The highest placed pony in the top 3 not already qualified will qualify for the NPS Summer Championships at Malvern on 1st to 3rd August. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the finals.
This show is a qualifier for the N.C.P.A Pony of the Year Show on 3rd September. First and second prize winners in appropriate classes will qualify.

This show is a qualifier for the 'NCPA Junior M&M Pony of the Year' final to be held at the Northern Counties Pony of the Year Show on 3rd September Aff No 282/23

This show is affiliated to Equifest, taking place at Arena UK, Grantham, Lincolnshire on 2nd - 5th August 2023. The two highest placed exhibits not already qualified in each affiliated class will qualify.

This show is a qualifier for the Northern Breeders In Hand Championship Sponsored by "MP GLOSS PRODUCTS UK" to be Held at NPS Area 4 Show on Monday 28th August.

This show is a qualifier for **The Price Family Supreme In Hand Horse Or Pony Of The Year Semi Final** to be held at The National Pony Society Great British In Hand Show on 2nd September 2023, which is a qualifier for the Horse of The Year Show, NEC, 4th to 8th October 2023. The objective of the competition is to find the Supreme light horse or pony in hand champion of the year, irrespective of breed or type (excluding heavy horses).



The Champion pony from the following classes will be eligible to compete in the Supreme In Hand Semi final, provided it has not already won a Supreme In Hand Qualifier in 2023:

- Stallion Championship.
- Female Championship.
- Youngstock Championship.

If the Champion has already qualified for HOYS final or is ineligible then the Reserve Champion may come forward to the NPS Great British In Hand Show. If both Champion and Reserve have qualified or are ineligible then the semi final will not be represented at the Great British In Hand Show. Foals and geldings four years old and over are not eligible.

In the event of a horse/pony having been awarded more than one section Championship at this show, that horse/pony will represent both/all sections and the Semi-Final qualification will not pass down to the Reserve Champion in the 2nd and any subsequent sections.

All classes are open to Yearlings, 2 year olds, 3 year olds, Stallions, broodmares and barren mares only.

Broodmares must be with foal at foot or a relevant certificate of pregnancy. Mares which have not yet foaled or that have lost their foals are eligible to enter with a relevant certificate of pregnancy for the following year.

There will be no direct entry into the Supreme In-Hand Championship Semi Final, all animals must be a section champion or reserve champion (as applicable).

1st = 6 points 2nd = 5 points 3rd = 4 points 4th = 3 points 5th = 2 points 6th = 1 point

Child Friendly Trophy

The Whittington Family Trophy and rosette will be awarded to the pony the judges consider to be the most child friendly, and will qualify to compete for The Tawbitts Shield at the Exmoor Breed show in August.



Rules

All ponies must be registered in the main section of the EPS stud book. Registration numbers & breeding must be quoted on the entry form, or the entry will not be accepted.

All ponies entered in Ridden classes must be 4 years old or over except Class 16 is for 15 years and over. Spurs are not allowed in any class.

Brood mares must be 4 years old or over. Foals must be at least 3 weeks old or over on the day of the show and must accompany their dam into the ring and be led alongside the mare as much as possible.

Stallions and colts 3 years old and over must be in possession of EPS license. Stallions and colts 2 years old or over must be bitted. Riders of stallions must have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Handlers of stallions or colts must have attained their 14th birthday before 1st January of the current year. No stallions in classes 11,12,13 or 19.

Any pony not under proper control will be asked to leave the showground.

No liability for any injury or loss to any person, animal or goods will be accepted by the Exmoor Pony Society, show organisers or owners of the venue. It is solely the responsibility of each individual attending this event to ensure that they have adequate insurance cover.

Correctly secured current British standard skull caps/riding hats must be worn at all times while mounted. Handlers aged 16 years and under must wear correctly secured current British standard skull caps/riding hats in all in hand classes.

The judge's decision is final. We do not encourage complaints. Any complaint must be made to the secretary NOT to the judges or stewards. If you really must complain, your complaint will only be heard by the secretary on receipt of a £50 fee which is not refundable and will be given to charity. There is no right of appeal against any decision made by the secretary as a result of hearing any such complaint.

The organisers reserve the right to alter, amalgamate, divide or cancel any class as required.

Classes may be entered on the day as long as the pony is pre entered in at least one class.

Pre entry fees are £10 per class, entries on the day £15

NPS Qualifying rounds, Breed Show Rules: These classes are judged under the rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland stud books. Part bred are not eligible for mountain & moorland classes.

Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members and at breed show ponies can qualify for finals even if their owners are not members. Owners of qualified ponies must become adult Qualifying or Life members to enter the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1st to 3rd August 2023.

The highest placed pony in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.

NPS/Corscaron Horse Essentials Home-Produced Ridden Championship -Riders of home produced ponies (See definition in NPS Rules Book) can wear a white armband in classes where this is indicated. These ponies are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship show.
